The sides and tops of Boxes are made of sheet steel, copper-plated and lacquered. The construction of sides and tops being of this metal, enables us to give a larger Box in the same space than those made of wood.

The "Corbin" Lock is made especially and used only for Post-Office Boxes. This Lock has an almost unlimited number of changes, and is most admirably adapted in every particular for Post-Office Boxes.

TO POSTMASTERS.

N POST-OFFICES, where the salary is less than \$1,000.00, the income received from rental of boxes belongs to the Postmaster. If the Postmaster can furnish to his patrons a handsome outfit, conveniently arranged, he can considerably increase the income of the office. With this in view, we present the largest and most complete line of Boxes and Cabinets made by any concern. Our factory at Lake Geneva, Wis., was built and equipped with the most improved and tools, especially for Post-Office work. At our factories in New Britain, Conn., the Metal Boxes and Locks are made by

machinery and tools, especially for Post-Office work. At our factories in New Britain, Conn., the Metal Boxes and Locks are made by skilled workmen, and in presenting either the "Corbin," "Harvard," or other locks, we guarantee them to be the most secure and best adapted for Post-Office work.

It is our intention to carry Cabinets in stock at Lake Geneva, Wis., and New Britain, Conn., so that prompt shipment can be made from either point. Sample Boxes and Cabinets are shown at New York, Chicago, and San Francisco Warehouses.

In addition to illustrations shown, we are prepared to furnish designs and estimates on receipt of sketch giving dimensions of room, showing position of doors and windows, and stating number of Lock and Call Boxes wanted. These drawings we will furnish without charge, and in naming price the Postmaster will know exactly what the complete office will cost.

TERMS OF PAYMENT.

We offer to Customers two plans for payment of Cabinets or Outfits.

CASH PLAN. Cabinets and Outfits ordered on this basis are to be paid for on receipt of shipment.

INSTALLMENT PLAN. Cabinets and Outfits ordered on this plan are to be paid for by remitting one-fourth of the installment price on receipt of shipment, and balance by three notes, payable quarterly, without interest.

RENTAL OF LOCK BOXES.

Any Postmaster desiring to rent Lock Boxes will be furnished with terms on application. State number of Boxes and size wanted, and manner in which they are to be arranged and numbered. We will then send rental agreement for signature, and on its return will forward the Lock Boxes.






TO OPEN LOCK WITH MASTER-KEY.

Insert small end of key in the slot of Center, A, and turn to the left one quarter turn, which throws Center, A, from the position shown in Fig. 1 to that shown in Fig. 2. Then insert Master-Key in Hub, B, and turn to the left as far as possible, which will throw the Bolt, C, from the position shown in Fig. 1 to that shown in Fig. 2. Withdraw Master Key, Again insert end of key in the slot of Center, A, and turn to the left another quarter turn, which throws the Center, A, from the position shown in Fig. 2 to that shown in Fig. 3. The Lock is now ready for any key


 The Lock is now ready for any key which may be inserted from the front-side, and the Bolt thrown, same as in changing from one key to another.


TO CHANGE KEYS.

Open the Box with key already fitted to it, press the thumb against end of Bolt, at same time turn the key as to unlock, making one half revolution of key and cylinder; remove key while in this position, and lock with new key.

When all keys are lost, open with a Master-Key, one or more of which are furnished with every office.

The "Harvard" Lock.






Key used with "Harvard" Lock.
Three Keys to each Lock.

The "Harvard" Lock is made of Bronze Metal. Each Lock has six pins or tumblers and differs from every other lock. Each Lock has three German-silver grooved keys. The Latch device is the same as is used in the "Corbin" Lock.

All Locks are secured to front with machine screws.

The "Geneva" Lock.

The "Geneva" Lock is made of Brass, with a heavy Bronze cap, tube, and centre. The Lock has five tumblers or levers, and is self-locking. Three German-silver keys are furnished with each Lock, and each Lock is different change from every other Lock. All Locks are secured to front with machine screws.

Extra Keys are furnished to Postmasters only by sending number stamped on key.

The "Corbin" Bronze-Metal Lock Box.

The Door and Frame of the "Corbin" Lock Box are made of the best quality of Bronze Metal, nicely finished and lacquered. The hinge is so constructed that it is impossible to remove the door until the Lock is unlocked.

The "Corbin" Lock, used on No. 1 and No. 2 Boxes and No. 3 Drawer, was adopted by the United States Government in 1888, and possesses features not attained in any other lock. Each Lock is provided with three nickel-plated flat steel keys.

The **Box** is made of **No. 21 sheet-steel** which is copper-plated and lacquered, and the frame is securely attached to the steel box. The sheet-steel box furnishes more room than the ordinary wood boxes, and the metal being flush with the frame presents a perfectly smooth box inside.

The Openings are glazed with heavy plate Glass. The glass is large so that box renter can readily see the contents of box.

The Numbers are plain black or white figures, on a white, or black plate, placed inside of the box in such a manner that they cannot be chipped off or defaced.

The "Corbin" No. 2 Bronze-Metal Lock Box.

The Doors and Frames are made of the best quality of Bronze Metal, nicely finished and lacquered.

The **Lock** in the "Corbin" Lock is described on page 3. Each Lock has three nickel-plated flat steel keys.

The Box is sheet-steel, copper-plated and lacquered, and is securely attached to the frame—flush with the frame—leaving the inside of the box perfectly smooth.

The Panels are made of heavy plate glass. The glass is large so that box renter can readily see contents of box.

The Numbers are plain black, or white figures, on a white, or black plate, placed inside the box; and the figures cannot be chipped off or defaced.





"Corbin" and "Harvard" Lock Boxes.

We present a nest containing "Corbin" and "Harvard" Lock Boxes. It will be seen that three No. 1 "Corbin" (or three No. 5 "Harvard") Boxes are same width as two No. 2 "Corbin" (or two No. 6 "Harvard") Boxes, and two No. 2 "Corbin" (or two No. 6 "Harvard") Boxes occupy the same width as one No. 3 "Corbin" (or one No. 7 "Harvard") Drawer.

Height: — Multiply the number of Boxes high by height of each of such Boxes given above and add 21/2 inches for roundabout at top and bottom.

Width: — Multiply the number of Boxes wide by the width of each of such Boxes given above and add 21/4 inches for roundabout at ends.


Thus 100 No. 1 Boxes, 10 wide and 10 high, equal 10 x $35/8 + 2\frac{1}{4} = 38\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide, and 10 x $5 + 2\frac{1}{4} = 52\frac{1}{4}$ inches high.

When necessary to remove a Box, the same can be taken from screen without interfering with any other box.

The "Harvard" Bronze-Metal Lock Box.

The "Harvard" Lock Box differs from the "Corbin" Lock Box only in the Lock.

The Doors and Frames and sheet-steel Box are the same as used in the "Corbin" Box.

The Lock used in the "Harvard" Box is the "Harvard" Lock, and although not possessing the many advantages of the "Corbin" Lock, is a nicely made and very secure lock. (See page 3.)

The "Harvard" Lock is made with six pins or tumblers, and each lock is made different from every other lock. The "Harvard" Lock has an almost unlimited number of changes. Each lock is furnished with three grooved German-silver keys.







"Acme" Bronze-Metal Lock Boxes.

These Fronts are made of Bronze Metal of neat design and are nicely finished and lacquered.

The Locks used are the "Geneva" Bronze Spring Locks, made especially for Post-office work. Each Lock has three German silver keys and each lock is of different change from every other lock. Locks cannot be picked or get out of order, and are so constructed that they can be opened from the inside by the Postmaster, and the box renter can also be locked out from inside of office.

Heavy Plate Glass is used for the opening in front.

The Numbers are plain white figures on a black plate, placed inside the box in such a manner that they cannot be chipped off or defaced.

The Boxes are made of whitewood for the sides and with wire or wood bottom, and the Bronze Metal Front is securely attached to the hard wood frame.

Each Box is provided with brass name clip and blank card for name of box renter.

The **Numbers** are plain white figures on a black plate, placed inside the box, and cannot be chipped off or defaced.

The **Boxes** are made of whitewood for the sides, and with wire or wood bottom, and the Bronze Metal Front is securely attached to hard wood frame.





"Acme" Bronze-Metal Lock Boxes.

We present a nest containing 36 No. 10 "Acme" Lock Boxes, 8 No. 11 "Acme" Lock Boxes, and 4 No. 12 "Acme" Lock Boxes.

It will be seen that three of the No. 10 Boxes occupy the same width as two No. 11 Boxes, and two of the Nos. 10 or 11 Boxes occupy the same height as one No. 12 Box.

The "Acme" Lock Box Fronts are made of Bronze Metal of neat design, highly finished and lacquered, and present a handsome appearance.

The Locks used are the "Geneva" Bronze Spring Locks, made especially for Post-office Boxes. No two locks are alike, and will not interchange, and each lock has three flat German silver keys. Locks are so constructed that they can be opened from the inside by Postmaster, and box renter locked out, if desired.

The opening in front is glazed with Heavy Plate Glass.

The **Numbers** are **white** letters on a **dark** plate, placed inside of the box in such a manner that they cannot be chipped off or defaced.

The Boxes or Pigeon Holes are made of well-seasoned whitewood, smoothly finished, and with wire or wood bottom.

The Fronts are securely attached to the hard-wood frames, and present a perfectly smooth surface inside of box.

For Estimating Space to be Occupied by "Acme" Lock Boxes.

Height: - Multiply the number of Boxes high by height of each (see page 14) and add 2 inches for roundabout.

Width: - Multiply the number of Boxes wide by width of each (see page 14) and add 2 inches for roundabout.

Thus 100 No. 10 "Acme" Lock Boxes, 10 wide and 10 high, equal 10×3 1/8 + 2=40 1/4 inches wide, and 10×5 1/4 + 2=54 1/2 inches high.

NUMBERING.

The numbering adopted and used on the "Corbin," "Harvard," "Acme," and "Excelsior" Lock Boxes differs from that used on other boxes. Instead of placing the numbers on the inside of the box on the glass, thereby being continually brought in contact with mail matter, resulting in erasing or chipping off the numbers, our numbers are placed on a plate separate from glass and cannot be reached by mail matter. We furnish black numbers on a silvered plate, or white numbers on a black plate, either of which presents a handsome appearance and can be readily seen.

All Cabinets and Outfits, unless otherwise ordered, will be numbered in the following manner: Commencing at the upper left-hand corner with No. 1, the second tier No. 11, the third tier No. 21, etc., the second horizontal row being numbered 2, 12, 22, etc. If the boxes are but eight rows high, the numbers 9, 19, 29, etc., and 10, 20, 30, etc., are omitted.

No. 15 "Excelsior" Bronze-Metal Lock Boxes.

These Fronts are made of Bronze Metal, nicely finished and lacquered.

The Locks used are the "Geneva" Spring Bronze Lock, made especially for post-office work. Each lock has three German silver keys. Each lock is made of different change from every other lock. Locks cannot be picked or get out of order, and are so constructed that they can be opened from the inside by the Postmaster. The box renter can also be locked out from inside of office.

Heavy Plate Glass is used for the opening in the front. The opening being large, the contents of box is readily seen.

Numbers are plain white figures on a black plate, placed inside the box in such a manner that they cannot be chipped off or defaced.

Boxes are made with Wire or Wood Bottoms, and the front is securely attached to the hard wood frame. Each Box is provided with Brass Name Clip and blank card for name of box renter.

Inside measurement of box, 37/8 inches wide, 43/8 inches high, 9 inches deep, price, \$1.50 each.

No. 15 "Excelsior" Bronze-Metal Lock Boxes.

The No. 15 Lock Boxes were made especially for use in Cabinets, and are so constructed as to occupy equal space and nest with Call Boxes in Cabinets shown in following pages.

In height Nos. 15 and 20 Lock Boxes are same as No. 25, but in width Nos. 15 and 20 Lock Boxes are 38 inch wider than No. 25.

In Estimating Space to be occupied by No. 15 Lock Boxes.

Height: - Multiply the number of Boxes high by height of each (5 inches) and add 2 inches for roundabout.

Width: - Multiply the number of Boxes wide by width of each (43% inches) and add 2 inches for roundabout.

Our new Wood-Front Lock Boxes have won for themselves a high reputation for convenience and security, beauty of design, and ornamental appearance. The Fronts are made and finished in the best possible manner of black walnut, or other hard wood, with glass in the center to admit light and allow the contents of the box to be readily seen. The boxes are numbered on the inside of the glass with an oil number, gold shaded with red, which gives the best effect. The Locks are the "Geneva" Bronze Spring Locks which are made especially for Post-Office boxes. The strong point about these locks is that they cannot be picked, cannot get out of order, and each lock is of a different change from any other lock. The Keys are made of German silver and will not rust. Three Keys are sent with each box. Locks are so constructed that the doors can be opened from inside of the office by Postmaster. Boxes supplied with Wire or Wood bottom as desired.


Full size cut of No. 21 Wood-Front Lock Box.


Full size cut of No. 22 Wood-Front Lock Box.

Wood-Front Lock Boxes are carried in stock, made in sections of 7, 8, 14, 16, 21, 24, 28 and 32 Boxes, and can be shipped immediately on receipt of order.

The No. 20 Lock Box is same height as our regular Call Box (No. 25), and the Cabinets and outfits illustrated on the following pages show No. 20 Lock Boxes used in connection with No. 25 Call Boxes.

Lock Boxes Nos. 1, 5, 15 and 20 can be placed in Cabinets and outfits, and occupy the same height as No. 25 Call Box.

All Locks used in Lock Boxes are so constructed that the keys will not interchange.

"Corbin" Wire-Bottomed Call Boxes.

We furnish Wire-Bottomed Call Boxes made in three sizes, Nos. 25, 26, and 27. These boxes are made of well-seasoned and selected wood, and the bottom of brass wire, which prevents an accumulation of dust. The numbers are securely fastened in front of box independent of glass, so that in case glass should be broken, the numbers would not have to be replaced.

At the rear of each box are the brass number clips fastened to end of box, numbered to correspond with box and provided with space to insert name of box renter, and with card board blank for name. These brass name clips are furnished without extra charge.





Rear View of No. 36 Cabinet.


