#### THE POSTAL HISTORY OF MACAO 1796 TO 1900

The earliest letters originating in Macao were carried by private vessels and do not bear postal markings of origin. Regular Portuguese packet service operated between Macao and Portugal between 1825 and 1837 and these letters bear Portuguese postal markings. Postal markings began to be applied at Macao circa 1830 for letters carried on these packets.

During the period between 1837 and 1846 a variety of poorly understood mail services were in operation for mail originating at Macao. These include private boats operating on the river between Canton, Hong Kong and Macao as well as the British Agency and private mail forwarders operating to assure mail connections.

Between 1846 and 1884 Macao the bulk of the mails were handled through the British Post Office in Hong Kong. The office at Macao can be properly classified as a Hong Kong dependent office during this period. The postal markings are largely of British design and usage of the British mail service prevailed.

The first official Portuguese post office was not established in Macao until 1884, at which time Macao issued its first postage stamps. Although a member of the Universal Postal Union, postal rates varied by method of transmission as well as destination.

This exhibit will show the various markings and usages associated with mails from Macao between 1796 and 1900. Also included are a few items that show typical inbound, or transit usages. The pre-adhesive portion is organized roughly in chronological order by the type of mails service that handled the letter. The balance of the exhibit is dedicated to the usage of Macao adhesive stamps on cover, organized by date.


Virtually all pre 1900 postal material from Macao is rare and even the most common markings of the pre-adhesive period are known in less than thirty or forty examples. This exhibit contains several usages that are the only reported examples, such as the "Postboat" handstamp, as well as the earliest reported letter from Macao bearing a postmark. Other important usages include fourteen copies of Hong Kong 96c used from Macao, and the only reported example of the "Macao A" postmark.

The Macao adhesive period material shown includes almost a quarter of the known covers. Non philatelic covers prior to 1900 from Macao exist from only a handful of correspondences.
